STAKES Florida Stallion Dr. Fager S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$2,500 each (Stallion) ; \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start. The added money together with all nomination fees, eligibility payments, entry and starting fees to be divided - Approximately 12.5% of gross purse August 7 after distribution of Stallion Nominator and Breeders' Awards; Approximately 20.5% of gross purse August 28 after distribution of Stallion Nominator and Breeders' Awards; Approximately 66.5% of gross purse October 16 after distribution of Stallion Nominator and Breeders' Awards. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Stallion and Breeders' Awards to be distributed according to Florida Statute in effect on the date of the race. Weight: 118 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner. Nominations for Stallions closed on February 15, 2007 with 124 Stallion Nominations. (No Supplementary Nominations). Closed Monday, June 14, 2010 with 634 nominations.

GOURMET DINNER unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up late. GRANDE SHORES rated off the pace, raced four wide around the turn, rallied to gain the lead in early stretch but couldn't resist the winner in the closing strides. VEE'S ACCOLADE outrun early, swung wide for the stretch run, rallied to loom a threat in midstretch, was steadied when he lugged in behind GOURMET DINNER, then lugged in bumping soundly with WATCH ME GO and was up for the show. DECISIVE MOMENT pressed the pace four wide, moved to gain a slim lead at the quarter pole, made the pace into the stretch, bumped soundly with WATCH ME GO in deep stretch, then was bumped hard again when that rival was forced into him and gave way. WATCH ME GO chased the pace, angled out and rallied to join the leaders in the stretch, bumped soundly with DECISIVE MOMENT in deep stretch, then was knocked into that rival by VEE'S ACCOLADE, steadied and tired. LITTLE DRAMA pressed the pace three wide to nearing the stretch and faltered. DUAL EXHAUZE showed speed off the rail to nearing the stretch, then faded. Following a stewards inquiry and claims of foul by the riders of DECISIVE MOMENT and WATCH ME GO, VEE'S ACCOLADE was disqualified and placed fifth for interference to those rivals in deep stretch. .
