CROWN GLORY broke outward, was quickly straightened and stalked the pace three wide, steadily advanced four wide nearing the lane, moved to command near mid stretch then kicked away under a drive. DRICA'S LUCK rushed clear nearing the five eighths pole, set the pace removed from the rail, was collared in upper stretch, dueled briefly near the furlong marker then stayed on well to be second best. NERVOUS NELL lost ground five to seven wide, made some progress inside the furlong marker then flattened out. KATHY'S RIBBONS stalked the early pace, dropped back some into the turn, raced three wide nearing the quarter pole, worked well wide past the eighth pole and finished with interest. CUGATCHA rated in mid pack early, angled out and circled the turn five wide, shifted out eight wide in the lane but lacked a rally. PINK GLOSS, away alertly, chased the pace three wide and faded. MIZZEN THE RHYTHM, between rivals near the quarter pole, was not a factor. READY TO MAMBO saved ground and faded.
