JACKSON BEND was caught in tight soon after entering the backstretch, stalked the pace, then rallied along the rail to catch MR. GREEN at the sixteenth pole and prevailed. MR. GREEN vied for the lead along the inside, came out a bit for the stretch run while continuing to make the pace to the sixteenth pole, then couldn't resist the winner while clearly best of the rest. BIM BAM reserved early, swung wide for the stretch run and closed to gain the show. GESU chased the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. TUTOR was not a factor. PERFECT STUDENT tired from good position. RAGING TRIPP chased the pace to midway of the turn, then faltered. LITTLE MIKE vied for the lead outside MR. GREEN to the top of the stretch and faded. CORTADITO was outrun after hesitating at the start.
