ELTISHA raced three wide around the turn, rallied to take over nearing the eighth pole and edged away. SUPERBOWL PICC rated off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and closed to be up for the place. INDIGO MOON chased the pace along the inside to past the eighth pole and weakened. MADAME GLAMOUR set the pace along the inside into the stretch and gave way. UP TO WIN outrun early, gained some ground in the drive without threatening. MAN I LOVE CLARE chased the pace, made a run at the leader on the turn, then tired in the drive. LACY LADY turned in a dull effort.
