**Footnotes**

STARSHIP VALOR stalked the pace, rallied three wide to take over on the far turn, shook off a challenge from CASINO GAMBLER in the stretch and opened a clear lead at the sixteenth pole, then was fully extended to last over READY IN THE MORN. The latter, reserved early, angled out in the stretch and rallied to just miss. CASINO GAMBLER stalked the pace, made a run inside STARSHIP VALOR to reach near even terms for command with that rival at the eighth pole, then weakened. ENGINERY failed to menace. BOBS TIEBREAKER chased the pace around the turn and tired. RUSTY CHARLIE showed speed along the rail to the quarter pole, then faltered.
