MADE IN U. S. A. vied for the lead off the rail, drew clear in the stretch, then was all out to prevail. L'S TICKET TO RIDE unhurried after breaking slowly, angled out for the stretch run and closed well for the place. LAW REVIEW chased the pace four wide into the stretch but had no response when asked. HIGH RED STAR broke a step slowly, saved ground and failed to menace. BARRY'S IMAGE rated off the pace, tired. QUALITY JACK vied for the lead three wide around the turn, then faltered. T'S MASTER TABLE off a step slowly, raced with the pace along the rail into the turn and faded.
