Footnotes

EDISTO LADY stalked the pace along the rail, angled outside MISS GOLD INDY in the stretch, rallied to gain a slim lead at the eighth pole, then was all out to repulse SHIFT IT and prevail. The latter, reserved racing along the inside, angled wide for the stretch run, made a run at the winner through the final eighth but couldn't get to that rival while clearly second best. EXCHANGE CHIC unhurried early, swung wide for the stretch run and improved her position to be up for the show. BLUSHING TIGER outrun early, advanced along the rail to reach contention in the stretch but failed to menace after being caught inside MISS GOLD INDY late. STARSHIP STREAKER rated off the pace after breaking slowly, advanced three wide around the far turn to loom a threat in the stretch, then tired. MISS GOLD INDY showed speed off the rail to the eighth pole, then faltered. DA LADY VIKKI was not a factor. PLATINUM FLIPFLOPS was through after a half mile.
