Footnotes

LAWBOOK rated off the pace, angled out four wide on the turn, then rallied under pressure to wear down TRUST N LUCK late. The latter, vied for the lead between horses into the turn, drew clear from RUFUSTHEROADRUNNER in early stretch but couldn't hold off the winner late. SUPAH BLITZ reserved after breaking slowly, split rivals leaving the turn, then angled out in midstretch and closed to be best of the rest. RUFUSTHEROADRUNNER vied for the lead three wide into the stretch and tired. KING ROBYN chased the leaders four wide around the turn and gave way. KISSIN BOLD up close in the early going, faltered. WHITE BUCK off slowly, was always outrun. CERTAM SWEEP showed little after breaking slowly. SWEET PROMISES vied for the lead along the rail into the turn and faded. SCRUBS raced five wide and was through early.
