THEMUS unhurried after breaking slowly, raced five wide around the turn, rallied to take over inside the sixteenth pole and won going away. TUSCANY LIGHT lunged at the start, vied for the lead, moved to the inside on the turn while continuing to vie for the lead, edged clear in midstretch but was no match for the winner late while holding the place. STEP AND GO reserved early, saved ground around the turn, angled out while advancing to reach contention in midstretch but didn't do enough late. BANKER QUEEN allowed to settle, advanced four wide around the turn to loom a threat in the stretch, then flattened out. UNHURRIED off slowly, advanced along the rail, then was steadied in behind MISS HAVANA in the stretch and failed to recover. ADREALITY showed brief speed, raced three wide on the turn and tired. LITTLE INDIAN GIRL chased the pace along the inside and faltered. MISS HAVANA vied for the lead outside TUSCANY LIGHT, then drifted in front of UNHURRIED in the stretch while fading. VILOULA bobbled at the start, showed speed, then was steadied from between horses leaving the backstretch and stopped. SUMMER TONE was done early.
