**Footnotes**

TRUTH TO POWER reserved early, raced three wide on the far turn, rallied to catch STORM THIS just inside the eighth pole, then drew away. STORM THIS chased the pace, moved to take over on the far turn, then drifted out in the stretch and was no match for the winner after being straightened away. MIDATLANTIC stalked the pace into the stretch and tired. TAXICAB allowed to settle, passed tired rivals in the drive. REMEMBER ROBIN sprinted to a clear lead along the rail, made the pace to nearing the quarter pole, then had nothing left for the drive. ISLAND GINGER tracked the pace along the inside into the far turn, then tired. ROAD TO DAMASCUS was no factor after being outrun early. AWESOME RULER rated off the pace, faltered leaving the far turn. QUIET COUNTRY BOY broke poorly, steadied along the inside on the first turn, then faded on the far turn. LIMONADA showed little. COCHRAN steadied from close quarters soon after the start, stopped on the far turn and was pulled up at the top of the stretch.
