### Footnotes

HONORABLE N GNEISS showed speed off the rail, increased his advantage in midstretch, then was fully extended to hold sway. ENGINERY rated off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and rallied to be up for the place. STRAIGHT DRIVE chased the pace three wide into the stretch but had no late response. FABU IN unhurried after breaking a step slowly, passed tired rivals. SERAPI CAT tracked the pace along the inside around the turn and tired. NOVO SECRETO well placed racing along the rail, gave way in the drive. J V'S MAD HATTER chased the winner around the turn, then had nothing left for the stretch run. ELEVEN BELOW was not a factor. JUMP CUT was outrun. HARD MOONSHINE off slowly, showed little. ARROGANT CRUISER raced wide and was faltering when his rider lost his whip in the stretch. QUILLIGAN broke slowly, steadied in traffic on the backstretch and faded in the drive.
