LA TORERA tracked the pace three wide, rallied to gain the lead at the top of the stretch, then drew clear under urging. SOFI ANA chased the pace along the rail into the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner in the drive. BOSS LADY outrun after breaking slowly, raced three wide around the turn and closed to gain the show. SEXY THUNDER rated off the pace, raced five wide around the turn and never threatened. AMERICAN SPICE off slowly, rushed up to gain the lead, showed speed off the rail to the top of the stretch, then gave way. MOMS GLIDE was never a factor. DON'T LIKE TO FLY saved ground and tired. KEY WONDER showed some early foot and faltered. DUSTER tracked the leaders four wide into the turn, then faded.
