Footnotes

NOTIMETOKILL off a step slowly, chased the pace three wide, moved up to engage the leaders approaching the quarter pole, vied for the lead to inside the eighth pole, then edged away and was fully extended to hold off GIACOMO THE GREAT (VEN). The latter, unhurried early, raced off the rail and rallied for the place while unable to get to the winner. PRETTY ROWDY outrun after breaking awkwardly, saved ground around the turn, angled out and rallied for the show. ROLFSIE chased the pace off the rail, moved up midway of the turn to vie for the lead, contested the pace to inside the eighth pole and gave way. SANDALYE sprinted to a clear lead, made the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch, then tired. GOOD BOY DADDY was tracking the pace when his rider lost his whip on the backstretch, then faltered leaving the turn. STRAIGHTSUCCESS was outrun. RUN WILKO RUN was never a factor.
