Footnotes

NOTIMETOKILL stalked the pace, eased outside the leaders on the far turn, rallied to take over in early stretch and edged away. VANQUISHER rated off the pace, advanced off the rail to loom a threat in midstretch but couldn't sustain his bid while saving the place. TOM KITTEN reserved early, rallied along the rail to just miss the place. VALERIUS unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and gained some ground without threatening. PENITANT PRAYERS raced in striking position three wide into the stretch but had no response when asked. PALATINE HILL pressed the pace outside WROL UP, took over from that rival on the far turn, made the pace into the stretch and gave way. WROL UP set the pace under pressure along the rail into the far turn, then faded.
