CASH'S PRIDE rallied four wide on the far turn to take over command and drew clear under pressure. PRECIOUS FEATHER rated off the pace, angled out at the top of the stretch and continued on with good courage to prove second best. OCEAN AIR unhurried early, passed tired rivals to be up for the show. QUEEN OF OZ trailed after breaking slowly, then improved her position in the drive and just missed the show. MOON'S DUSTY STAR well placed, made a run three wide on the far turn to join the leaders, then tired in the drive. GOLD FOR MY GAL raced in striking position into the far turn and faltered. VEGAS ALARM made the pace along the inside into the far turn and gave way. DINNER PARDNER prompted the pace, moved to reach even terms for command on the far turn, then faded. DECAPOLIS showed little. MOP SQUEEZER saved ground and was through after a half mile.
