MISS BO BLUSH allowed to settle, advanced into contention between horses on the far turn, angled out in the stretch and rallied to be up late. LEAGLEYESER reserved early, saved ground around the far turn, came outside ETERNAL CLASSIC and rallied to gain a slim lead in midstretch but couldn't hold off the winner late. GITANITA unhurried early, saved ground and closed to be up for the show. ASK ME AGAIN tracked the leaders four wide around the far turn but couldn't gain in the stretch run. SARAH SAYS GO chased the pace three wide and weakened. CIRCE'S WISH outrun early, improved her position in the drive without threatening. HEY WHITEY was not a factor. ETERNAL CLASSIC set the pace along the hedge to midstretch and tired. LEAH'S SILVERADO was outrun. WANDERING PINE chased the pace, made a run at the leader racing down the backstretch, then faltered on the far turn. HONEYMOON SWEEP chased the leaders four wide to the far turn and faded. DEPARTING SOUTH (ARG) showed little.
