Footnotes

A FLEET PROSPECTOR stalked the pace three wide, rallied to catch WOOD ALLEY just inside the eighth pole, then was all out to edge that rival to the wire. WOOD ALLEY set the pace along the inside, responded when challenged by A FLEET PROSPECTOR, then dueled with that rival and just failed in a game effort. VIG prompted the pace outside WOOD ALLEY into the far turn, then gave way. UNTUTTTABLE AFFAIR rated off the pace, advanced four wide around the far turn to reach contention, then tired in the drive. CLOUDSOVERJOHN failed to menace after being checked from tight quarters on the first turn. BRAVE BANDITO reserved off the pace, faltered leaving the far turn. BRICKYARD ROAD was not a factor. MASSIVE STORM tracked the pace along the inside into the far turn, then faded. ROMAN WAGER was outrun after stumbling at the start.
