CRISTAL JAK showed speed off the rail into the stretch, then drew away when asked. HOLLYWOOD POSE rated off the pace, closed to gain the place while no match for the winner. MISS MARY FINN reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and couldn't keep pace with the top ones while up for the show. MY GAL JENNA chased the pace three wide to inside the eighth pole, then tired. SILVEREST broke awkwardly, then saved ground to no avail. SANSANNAH was not a factor. FLAME BURNS HIGHER pressed the pace along the rail into the turn and faltered. GREAT INTEGRITY was outrun. BLUE ANGEL EXPRESS showed little after being steadied when she broke in at the start.
