EASTER EASTER chased the pacesetter around the turn and gave way. WENDYWINS, off poorly, hustled up to be well placed and weakened. THAT'S OUR PIC failed to threaten. STARSHIP ALARM saved ground to no avail. MISS BATES SWEEP, bumped at the start, was outrun. WILLY'S PHILLY, bumped at the start, trailed.
