SUGGESTION LISA bumped with DOUBLE BRISTOL at the start, showed speed off the rail into the stretch, then drew away under pressure. LAKE ALICE was chasing the pace when steadied along the inside on the backstretch, continued to chase the winner into the stretch but couldn't stay with that rival while clearly second best. VONNEGUT bounced around at the start, chased the pace three wide around the turn and tired. MARY KATE 'N KELLY steadied from inside LAKE ALICE in the early going, saved ground and faltered. TWO TIMING LASS was outrun after bumping with VONNEGUT at the start. SINJALEES WILDCAT off slowly, was never a factor. DOUBLE BRISTOL showed early foot after bumping with SUGGESTION LISA and bouncing off of VONNEGUT several times at the start, then faded.
