Footnotes

B L'S SASSY reserved off the pace, advanced along the hedge around the far turn to reach the attending position, eased outside UNFAIR in the stretch and rallied to be up in the final strides. UNFAIR set the pace along the hedge, increased her advantage around the far turn and into the stretch, then drifted into the gap late and couldn't resist the winner in the closing yards. BRILLIANT LOVER outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the show while no threat to the top ones. UNBRIDLED BREEDER allowed to settle after bumping with PENNY FOR LUCK at the start, steadied when caught in behind a wall of horses leaving the far turn, recovered and passed tired rivals. GRACE N GOODSPEED up close early, saved ground and tired. PENNY FOR LUCK well placed after bumping with UNBRIDLED BREEDER at the start, faltered in the drive. BOURBON NIGHT rated off the pace, raced in contention three wide around the far turn, then couldn't keep pace. HONALEE chased the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then had nothing left. VIA unhurried early, advanced four wide to loom a threat on the far turn, then faded in the drive. KELLYSEASTERBUNNY was steadied to avoid coming out into rivals on the first turn and was done early. SEEING THE STARS prompted the pace outside UNFAIR into the far turn and stopped. DARE I DREAM was

through after a half mile.
