**Footnotes**

ROY'S GIRLS showed speed off the rail, then drifted out through the stretch and lasted over KITCHENMAN. The latter's rider lost his right iron briefly when he bumped with REY OF THE ROAD at the start, chased the pace four wide around the turn, then drifted in while racing greenly under pressure in the stretch and closed to just miss catching the winner. WIRE CUTTER chased the winner three wide around the turn, then tired. TRUELEE SCRAPPIN off slowly, chased the leaders along the rail to the top of the stretch, then faltered. CODE TAKER stumbled at the start, then was no factor while racing four wide. FREEDOM LIGHT broke slowly, saved ground and faded. REY OF THE ROAD was outrun after bumping with KITCHENMAN at the start.
