SAMOA off slowly, advanced into contention on the far turn, swung to the outside for the drive and rallied to draw clear through the final sixteenth while drifting in under a hand ride. RUSSIAN SWEETIEPIE tracked the pace, moved to gain a slim lead leaving the far turn but couldn't match strides with the winner while holding the place. DIANA MY LOVE bumped and checked at the start, angled out at the top of the stretch and closed to be up for the show. YOUR SONG well placed after being bumped at the start, lacked a late response. DAJU chased the leaders around the far turn and tired. SUNRISE SERVICE sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, continued on well to midstretch and faltered. HEAR U KNOCKIN was no factor after being bumped at the start. GO WENT GONE was through early.
