LOST QUESTION stalked the pace three wide, rallied to take over inside the eighth pole, then edged away under pressure. MARIMAR LIGHT broke to the inside, moved up to vie for the lead outside COZZY CATE, edged clear from that rival on the turn but couldn't stay with the winner in the drive while holding the place. PEACE OFFERING unhurried early, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach contention in the stretch but didn't do enough late. BOOK THE BULLET tracked the pace off the rail into the stretch and weakened. DOCTOR DARLIN showed early foot, then couldn't keep pace around the turn. TALL HONOR outrun after being steadied at the start, raced four wide on the turn and was not a factor. COZZY CATE vied for the lead along the inside into the turn and faltered. TWIST THE SWORD was done early and eased in the final eighth. DONDOCA rated off the pace after being steadied at the start, faded leaving the turn and eased in the stretch run.
