PROUD WOLF, a step slow to break, advanced to the lead inside approaching the half mile pole, was rated to the turn, contested a slim disadvantage through the turn, regained control near the quarter pole and widened steadily after moving clear into the lane. CODY MACARONI showed no speed inside, closed while angling outward on the turn then continued to make up ground to reach place in deep stretch. PRESENTLY raced with the pace two deep on the backstretch, contested a slight advantage through most of the turn and dueled close to the top of the lane before yielding. STYLISH ACT chased the pace while off the rail, drifted out in the upper stretch then inward from the eighth pole; never threatening. NICHOLAS VISION gave chase from off the rail then weakened in the stretch. SURFER RANDY was never a factor. TWOFORONEBERT came away sharply with a brief early lead, gave chase through the backstretch but faded on the turn. PRINCE JACK, hesitant to load, showed no speed.
