TRIAL DATE, outrun early, angled outside the leaders after entering the stretch and rallied to be up in time. LUKE'S WAY, bobbled at the start, raced five wide on the turn and just missed. BEST OF THE REST vied for the lead between horses, gained a slim lead late and continued on gamely while being outfinished. BOODLE B vied for the lead from the outside and continued on with good courage to the wire. TEAMWORK set the pace along the inside under pressure and gave way in the final eighth. SIMM was outrun.
