ONE LAST TRICK, bumped at the start, set the pace under pressure, shook off a challenge from JOHNNY DOLLAR and drew clear under urging in the drive. JOHNNY DOLLAR rallied to reach the leader entering the stretch but couldn't stay with that rival in the drive while much the best of the others. SALTY SEA, hopped at the start, chased the leaders into the stretch and weakened. STAR ISLAND, unhurried early, improved his position in the drive. DR JOHNNY R, well placed early, tired. HOMECOURTADVANTAGE, bumped and checked at the start, was outrun. GORJEADOR, squeezed back at the start, failed to menace. DANCE THE BALLADO, bumped at the start, pressed the pace briefly and tired. BELFAST APPEAL, bobbled at the start, showed some early foot and stopped. JANGADEIRO was outrun.
