B B'S SONG chased the pace along the rail, rallied to gain the lead approaching the eighth pole, then was fully extended to prevail. COMPRISE reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the turn, angled out and rallied along the outside to be up for the place. IMMORTAL WINK showed speed along the inside, came out a bit for the stretch run and gave way grudgingly. MASTERWORK chased the pace three wide into the stretch but didn't do enough late. BLUES BROTHER failed to menace. ENGINERY chased the pace around the turn and tired. THREE POINT TICKET was not a factor. MOREAPPLAUSEPLEASE showed speed off the rail into the stretch, then faltered.
