Footnotes

BEA OF THE TIGER set the pace under pressure along the rail, edged away on the far turn, then was all out to last over AFLEET ALAN. The latter, unhurried after being steadied in the early going, raced four wide around the far turn and rallied to just miss. DINAHMITE SAL allowed to settle after being steadied in the early going, was racing along the inside when steadied again on the far turn, angled to the outside in the stretch and rallied to just miss catching the top ones. BLACK TIE SPIRIT rated off the pace, was blocked in behind a wall of horses on the far turn, found room and made a run to loom a threat in the stretch, then flattened out after his rider lost his whip inside the eighth pole. MR. IZZY reserved off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and found his best stride late. THE GADU ANGEL taken in hand early, rallied four wide around the far turn to reach the attending position, then gave way in the final eighth. BALTIMORE SAINT raced five wide around the far turn and never threatened. TABLE STAKES pressed the pace between horses into the far turn and tired. HOPE DEFERED pressed the pace three wide into the far turn, then faltered. ALINA'S LAD well placed while saving ground, faded in the drive.
