WIRE BOUND showed speed along the inside, responded when challenged by SEA CLIP at the quarter pole, then dueled with that rival to the wire and prevailed. SEA CLIP was bumped by FORMAL PASS at the start, pressed the pace outside WIRE BOUND, moved up to vie for the lead on the turn, then was just edged to the wire after a prolonged duel. SUPER CHEROKEE chased the pace three wide into the stretch, then lacked the needed late response. IMPERIALISM unhurried after being bumped and squeezed back from between rivals early, swung out for the stretch run and improved his position. MOMENT OF SONG bumped with IMPERIALISM soon after the start, chased the leaders four wide into the stretch and tired. CALLNEW failed to menace after being jostled between IMPERIALISM and ANOTHER ALPHABET in the early going. ANOTHER ALPHABET bumped with CALLNEW soon after the start, raced in contention into the turn and faltered. ALYAZULI was not a factor. HOT FINANCE off slowly, saved ground and faded. FORMAL PASS trailed after breaking slowly and bumping with SEA CLIP. The rider of IMPERIALISM lodged objections against the rider of both SEA CLIP and SUPER CHEROKEE for alleged interference soon after the start. The claims of foul were not allowed.
