FORMAL LADY chased the pace three wide, rallied to take over in early stretch and was fully extended to prevail. MAIDEN TOUR set the pace along the rail into the stretch, then couldn't stay with the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. TRI SOME IRISH chased the pace, made a run to gain a slim lead racing into the stretch, then weakened. MANGO LASSIE tracked the pace off the rail into the stretch and tired. SHOT GUN USS HOGA was not a factor. WICKLOW VAMP showed little and was eased in the final eighth. SENDA showed early foot along the inside, faded and was eased in the stretch run.
