BIG DRAMA pressed the pace outside RED NATION, took over from that rival at the quarter pole and drew clear, then remained clear to the wire under pressure. BEE CEE CEE chased the pace along the rail into the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner while closing to be up for the place. YOU LUCKIE MANN hit the gate at the start, then was bumped and steadied from between rivals soon after, raced three wide around the turn and finished willingly to just miss the place. SABI SABI showed early speed, was steadied on the backstretch, continued to chase the leaders around the turn, then gave way in the drive. THIS ONES FOR PHIL bumped with YOU LUCKIE MANN soon after the start, chased the pace three wide to inside the eighth pole, then tired. RED NATION set the pace under pressure along the inside to nearing the quarter pole, then faltered. B B'S SONG failed to menace. CODE RUNNER was not a factor. IRISH SPORT bumped with YOU LUCKIE MANN soon after the start and was outrun. IDEAL EXCHANGE off slowly, showed little. GRAND CENTRAL bolted racing down the backstretch and was eased.
