WHO PLAYS BRAHMS settled off the pace inside, was shuffled back on the rail approaching the final turn, eased three wide making a bid toward the quarter pole, exchanged light contact with Tut's Treasure past the quarter pole and again nearing the three sixteenths pole, dug in with the disadvantage from there but persisted to get up the final strides. TUT'S TREASURE rated off the pace about the four path, moved to a threatening position approaching the quarter pole, came out making contact with Who Plays Brahms just past the quarter pole, was then brushed by that one toward the three sixteenths pole, dueled clear past the eighth pole but outfinished the closing strides. SAVING GRACIE rated back off the rail, bid into the final turn, eased out for the drive and finished well. PUNT'S KITTY rated just off the pace about the three path, moved to threaten four wide near the quarter pole then lost ground into the stretch and leveled off from there. BRIDGE TO GOLD rated a slim lead off the rail, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. SPECIAL JAK stalked the pace inside and weakened toward the quarter pole. CUBAN CARMEN and LOVELY WILDCAT were not factors. TAYLORS IRISH rated off the pace outside, gave chase nearing the final turn then faded through the turn. BRACKETOLOGY was shuffled back at the start and never factored. An inquiry and subsequent claim of foul against the winning rider, lodged by the rider of the runner up, was reviewed before declaring this race official without change.
