Footnotes

TAKE ADVANTAGE prompted the pace two wide, moved to near even terms past the five sixteenths pole, gained a slim advantage entering the stretch, dueled from there, dug in tenaciously under aggressive handling while between rivals and proved best. PORTRATURE , bumped and forced out at the break, settled off the pace, came under pressure leaving the far turn, rallied four wide into the lane, ranged up outside rivals past the eighth pole, finished gamely and just got the place. FEDERAL EXCHANGE set the pace inside, took pressure leaving the far turn, dueled from the quarter pole to deep stretch and stayed on well. HONOR'S GOLD had a shoe repair, was bumped and forced out into PORTRATURE at the break, moved up under snug restraint the first turn, settled down a bit leaving the three quarter pole and stalked the pace, was asked for run five sixteenth's out, chased into the lane then faded. JACKWAGON came out at into HONOR'S GOLD at the start, saved ground in range, was put to a ride exiting the three furlong marker and weakened in upper stretch.
