Footnotes

TRIPSKI rated kindly off of a contested pace, responded when asked mid turn, circled five wide into the stretch, closed under strong handling, rolled to the front near the sixteenth marker and drew clear. DON'T SAY NO was steady when bumped and put in close soon after the break, angled out and moved up into the turn, made a four wide run into the stretch, bid to near even terms a furlong out but lacked the needed finish. QUIZ WHIZ set a pressured paced inside and stayed on well. ASSET EXCHANGE, off slowly when unprepared as the gates opened, raced wide and closed willingly. A CENTURIAN gunned up soon after the break, vied two to three wide, held well to mid stretch then gave way. TROUBLES COMIN was carried out very wide near the three eighths pole and failed to recover. GRANDE SHORES, sluggish from the gate, was not a factor. NEWSPAPER BOY, bumped at the break, saved ground stalking the early pace, stumbled and bore out entering the turn eliminating TROUBLES COMIN, angled back in some and failed to threaten. There was a stewards' inquiry into the run into the turn but no action was taken
