### Footnotes

PUT IT ALL IN , patiently handled when moving up behind rivals near the quarter pole, swung out five wide in upper stretch, rallied to draw even a sixteenth from the wire, dueled outside THIS ONE'S FOR MEL, was floated out late by that one and got the nose bob. THIS ONE'S FOR MEL , three to four wide, steadily advanced into the stretch, poked a head in front inside the eighth pole, dueled inside the winner, came out late under left handed pressure and just missed in a game effort. HEAR ME COMIN was lightly steadied off heels nearing the turn, made a run between rivals in mid stretch, briefly lost momentum soon after, regrouped and finished with interest. BIG EXPERIENCE stalked the pace, moved three wide under a ride to challenge mid turn, dueled on a short lead into the lane, briefly spurted clear but failed to last. BARRY'S IMAGE chased the pace, made a run up the rail in upper stretch, shifted out late and came up empty. EXCELLENT KING sprinted clear from the outside, dropped in to set the pace two wide, was taken on after a half, dueled into the lane then tired a furlong out. ARTIE OCEAN broke slowly and was distanced. There was a steward's inquiry involving the top two finishers in the stretch run. No action was taken.
