NATASHA'S RENO chased the pace, rallied to catch SEEYOUATTHEDANCE at the eighth pole and was fully extended to prevail. DANCING GATE chased the pace along the inside, altered course outside the leaders nearing the eighth pole and closed to be up for the place. SOCIAL PLACE reserved racing off the rail, closed with a mild response to gain the show. SEEYOUATTHEDANCE sprinted to a clear while angling over to the inside, then weakened in the drive. LIZARD LICK was no threat after being outrun early. FREE SPIRITESS bumped with JAMIE'S WAGER at the start and was not a factor. WAGER'S BONUS bumped with JAMIE'S WAGER at the start and was outrun. JAMIE'S WAGER squeezed between rivals at the start, raced three wide on the turn and faltered.
