ROCKY O' ROURKE chased the pace three wide, rallied to take over leaving the turn and drew off under urging. SUPAHBUCKDANCE vied for the lead outside SAN SABA to nearing the stretch, then was no match for the winner while continuing on with good courage to hold the place. DIAMOND FLASH off slowly, was outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the show. SNOW TRICK unhurried after being checked at the start, advanced three wide around the turn to reach contention but had no response when set down for the drive. MR. SHIPMAN failed to menace. BUCKETFUL OF HOPE was not a factor after being steadied at the start. SAN SABA vied for the lead along the rail to nearing the stretch, then faltered. RICK'S WONDERBOY saved ground, faded and was eased in the final eighth.
