Footnotes

FRANKS REWARD , bumped at the break, saved ground advancing near the three eighths pole, angled out, worked between rivals leaving the five sixteenths marker, rallied four wide under pressure to collar STARSHIP CAPTAIN, was brushed when that rival drifted out approaching the sixteenth pole, took command soon after, dueled and held sway. STARSHIP CAPTAIN tracked three wide under rating, moved to command into the lane, kicked clear in upper stretch, drifted out making contact with the winner near the sixteenth pole, was straightened away and battled gamely to the wire. HEY BRAYDEN dueled two wide, briefly opened a daylight advantage mid turn, was joined a quarter mile out, gave little resistance and faded. ROJOTHEMAGNIFICO , bumped at the break, raced removed from the inside near the three eighths pole and failed to generate the needed kick. RED ZONE FLYER , four wide, made some progress approaching the lane then flattened out. WHITE THUNDER , bumped and pinched back at the break, was outrun. WHATSUPNOTMUCH gained the early lead, dueled along the rail to the turn then faltered. There was a stewards' inquiry into the stretch run of the top two finishers but no action was deemed necessary
