CASHMERE KITTEN moved up between rivals near the five eighths pole and stalked the pace, forged to command three furlong out, dropped to the inside after going clear, drifted out under left handed urging in mid stretch, was corrected with the right stick and was all out to hold sway. PINAFRA , allowed to settle, commenced a run leaving the three eighths pole, circled four wide into the lane, loomed a furlong out but was second best. AVADAY lacked speed while saving ground, steadied off heels nearing the quarter pole, regrouped remaining inside and had some late interest. COUNTESS ALBIE gained command between rivals, edged clear seven furlongs out, set the pace along the rail, was taken on leaving the far turn, chased the winner into the lane and weakened. RACHEL'S GIRL , four wide stalking the pace, weakened. FERRETERA , ridden along while well off the early pace, swung out wide for the drive but failed to muster up any kind of substantial run. I CAN SEE MY DREAM rated in range three wide, was called upon for her best nearing the far turn, failed to kick in and gradually gave way.
