WELL EXCUUUZE ME quickly accelerated to the inside of LITTLE WISE GUY and took command leaving the five eighths pole, repelled a challenge from RUN SMART ONE with three eighths remaining, opened up a long lead into the stretch and proved best under a drive. SURGE POWER was lightly steadied off heels nearing the five furlong marker, angled in and stalked the pace, moved back out and gave chase three wide into the lane, was no match for the winner but stayed willingly to save the place. HIGH BRASS, unhurried early, made a four wide run inside a rival into the lane, chased past the eighth pole and flattened out. AQUA JEAN lagged back, saved ground throughout and passed fading rivals. TYLER'S WILDCAT saved ground early, angled out wide for the drive but failed to menace. RUN SMART ONE, in close attendance three wide, lodged a bid leaving the far turn, chased under strong urging past the five sixteenths marker and weakened. MIZE THE BIG CAT circled five wide making a mild run into the lane, drifted out near the sixteenth pole and came up empty. LITTLE WISE GUY cleared early, set the pace off the rail, faltered leaving the far turn and was eased through the lane.
