By subscription of \$75 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start - with \$55,000 guaranteed and an additional \$20,000 from the FTBOA Stakes Fund monies will be correspondingly divided provided a Florida Bred Registered with the FTBOA and/or by a sire registered with the FTBOA and or by a FSS nominated sire has finished in an awarded position. Any FTBOA Stakes fund monies not awarded will revert back to the fund. The Owner of the winner to receive 60%, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 allowed 3 lbs; \$25,000 in 2012 or two races other than maiden, claiming or starter, 5 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner. One (1) Supplemental nomination of \$1,075 to enter and start. Closed Saturday, August 4, 2012 with 17 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile).

EMPIRE BUILDER moved four wide nearing the half mile marker and joined HARRISON BAY, dueled, took command three furlongs out, drew clear into the stretch and held firm under a drive. MUSICAL FLAIR stalked the pace three wide, advanced into the lane, gave game pursuit and maintained the place. BELLEFIRE stalked the pace while saving ground, swung out in upper stretch and flattened out. ARGENTINE TANGO settled back while saving ground, came under pressure the far turn, swung out and closed between rivals. KINGS OVER, four wide, edged closer into the far turn, chased into the lane, drifted out and faded. ALL KNIGHT saved ground, angled out in upper stretch but lacked the needed bid. HARRISON BAY rushed clear early, set the pace towards the inside, dueled from the half mile marker, relinquished command around the far turn, chased and weakened. MR. ESPRESSO, off the rail, failed to respond. EL ROMANO lacked speed, came under pressure while wide the far turn but failed to kick in. DREAMING OF DANNY stalked the early pace and dropped back between rivals.
