COMPANY B stalked the pace three wide, moved to take over approaching the eighth pole, then drew away under urging. TASSO RUN off slowly, advanced four wide on the far turn to reach contention, then closed to be up for the place while no match for the winner. CAGEY MOVE stumbled at the start, steadied in traffic on the first turn, raced in striking position off the pace, then closed to be up for the show. PHARMSTAR prompted the pace, made a run to reach even terms for command entering the stretch, then weakened. SAILINGFORPENNIES set the pace along the rail into the stretch and tired. JADE BUTTERFLY steadied to avoid running up on the leader entering the first turn, saved ground and faltered.
