FLY SOUTH showed speed along the inside into the stretch, then drew clear when roused. DUKE OF HAZARD chased the pace along the rail into the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner while proving best of the rest. ANOTHER SUCCESS unhurried after breaking slowly, swung wide for the stretch run and closed to gain the show. CASINO GAMBLER chased the leaders off the rail into the stretch and gave way. CATCH RIKKI rated off the pace, made a run four wide to reach the attending position at the quarter pole, then tired. IN SPEIGHT OF IT was not a factor. GREAT VICTORIAN chased the winner off the rail into the stretch, then faltered. COCO TOP chased the pace three wide around the turn and faded.
