Footnotes

SOUTHERN MAGGIE tracked the pace along the rail, bumped with HALO JEZABELLE under left-handed urging while moving to gain the lead just past the eighth pole, then drew clear. LADY S tracked the pace three wide, rallied to gain a brief lead in the stretch, then was bumped by HALO JEZABELLE and couldn't stay with the winner while clearly second best. HALO JEZABELLE sprinted to a clear lead racing off the rail, made the pace into the stretch, then was tiring when knocked into LADY S in midstretch. CODE TWO allowed to settle, advanced four wide around the far turn to loom a threat racing into the stretch, then faltered. GREATEST DREAM tracked the leaders into the stretch and faded. HOPEWELL TERRACE trailed after stumbling at the start and was eased in the stretch run. A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE BUMPING INCIDENT IN THE STRETCH WAS DETERMINED TO HAVE NO EFFECT ON THE OUTCOME AND THE RACE WAS MADE OFFICIAL.
