BEAUTIFUL BEAU chased the pace three wide around the turn, then rallied to be up in the final strides while drifting out. COOPER'S SONG showed speed along the inside, increased her margin around the turn and continued on with good courage while unable to hold off the winner late. TOUR'S QUICK GAL rated off the pace, drifted in in early stretch and outfinished the others for the show. INFORMACION outrun early, swung wide for the stretch run and failed to menace. EXPECT ANNA chased the pace along the inside, then steadied in behind TOUR'S QUICK GAL in early stretch and tired. LOVELY DIAMOND was steadied when she broke to the outside at the start, raced three wide around the turn and faltered. URBANA LIGHT chased COOPER'S SONG into the stretch and faded. FIRING was done early.
