VIRTUOUS LADY showed speed off the rail, then drew away through the stretch while being kept to the task. LITTLEBITSAINLY broke out and bumped hard with OH PEGGY SUE soon after the start, chased the pace along the rail into the stretch, then was no match for the winner while edging JUDGE OF HONOR for the place. The latter, bounced around between rivals in the early going, prompted the pace three wide around the turn, then tired. ARLENE'S WILDEVENT unhurried after hesitating at the start, passed tired rivals in the drive. ISLAND MISS saved ground and faltered. CLASSY HANNAH bumped with JUDGE OF HONOR nearly unseating her rider and causing him to lose his right iron briefly, moved up to chase the pace to midway of the turn and faded. DUCHESS D'OR was not a factor. OH PEGGY SUE was outrun after being jammed back from between rivals soon after the start.
