Footnotes

DUKE OF HAZARD steadied from inside BABYLON RICH on the first turn, eased out to stalk the pace three wide, rallied to gain the lead in early stretch, then drew clear under pressure. GIMMEAWINKPOPPY set the pace under pressure racing off the rail into the stretch, then couldn't match strides with the winner while clearly best of the rest. SUPAH ALEX unhurried after hesitating at the start, passed tired rivals to gain the show and his rider lost his whip inside the eighth pole. BABYLON RICH pressed the pace along the rail to the top of the stretch, then tired. RAINBOW CRUISE rated off the pace, saved ground and faltered. TO HEIR IS HUMAN checked from tight quarters entering the first turn, tracked the pace to nearing the stretch and faded. STACK TOUR was no factor while racing three wide. HISTORYOFASAINTE trailed.
