PRECIOUS BEANS reserved racing along the inside, swung out for the stretch run, rallied to gain the lead at the eighth pole, then edged away. LANCE'S SONG vied for the lead between horses into the stretch, then couldn't stay with the winner in the final eighth while continuing on with good courage to prove clearly best of the rest. PRESENTLY hit the gate and bumped with NAGAJUSKITA at the start, vied for the lead three wide into the stretch, then tired. SONNY B CRUISIN' off slowly, failed to menace. TWO SAINTS tracked the pace duel to nearing the stretch and faltered. CALL ME JUNIOR broke slowly, rushed up to vie for the lead along the rail to nearing the stretch, then faded. EDDIE'S INK was no factor while racing three wide after being checked in traffic early. NAGAJUSKITA bumped with PRESENTLY at the start, then steadied from tight quarters in the early going and was outrun.
