NATHAN RIDGE rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, rallied to reach ANASHEED FLASH in midstretch, then wore that rival down late to prevail. ANASHEED FLASH stalked the pace off the rail, moved to take over on the far turn, responded when challenged by NATHAN RIDGE in the stretch and just failed to last in a game effort. UNITED STATES set the pace along the inside into the far turn and weakened. FACE THE CAT reserved early, improved his position without threatening. ENGINERY stalked the pace along the inside into the far turn and gave way. DECAF AGAIN saved ground and failed to menace. STATELY CHARACTER rated off the pace, advanced four wide down the backstretch to reach contention on the far turn, then tired in the drive.
